If you have any worries about your child's speech and development please speak to a member of staff and we will be glad to direct and support you as much as we can.

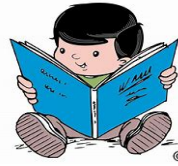
The BECC Childrens Centre, Borehamwood runs a Speech and Language class every week.
