MOBILE PHONE POLCY & PROCEDURE

TAS policies and procedures

1. The Nursery allows staff to bring in personal mobile telephones and devices for their own use during their break. Under no circumstances does the nursery allow a member of staff to contact a current pupil or parent/carer using their personal device.

2. Users bringing personal devices into nursery must ensure there is no inappropriate or illegal content on the device.

3. All staff must ensure that their mobile telephones/devices are left inside their bag or placed in the mobile phone box throughout contact time with children. Staff bags should be placed in the office away from children unless requested by the Manager/s to move them to another appropriate location

4. Mobile phone calls may only be taken at staff breaks or in staff members' own time.

5. If staff have a personal emergency they are free to use the setting's phone or make a personal call from their mobile in the designated staff area of the setting.

6. If any staff member has a family emergency or similar and required to keep their mobile phone to hand, prior permission must be sought from the Manager or Leader and the mobile phone should be placed in a container to be kept on a shelf within the base room, away from children's reach. Staff are not permitted the use of their phone outside of the stipulated emergency call. The call should be answered outside of the base room.

7. Staff (will need to) ensure that the Manager has up to date contact information and that staff make their families, children's schools etc. aware of emergency work telephone numbers. This is the responsibility of the individual staff member.

8. All parent helpers/students will be requested to place their bag containing their phone in the office and asked to take or receive any calls in the reception area.

9. During group outings nominated staff will have access to a nominated mobile phone agreed by the setting, which is to be used for emergency purposes only.

10. It is the responsibility of all members of staff to be vigilant and report any concerns regarding the use of mobile phones to the Nursery Manager or Leader. Concerns will be taken seriously, logged and investigated appropriately (see allegations against a member of staff

11. The Manager or Leader in her absence reserves the right to check the image contents of a member of staffs mobile phone should there be any cause for concern over the appropriate use

12. Should inappropriate material be found then our Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO) will be contacted immediately. We will follow the guidance of the LADO as to the appropriate measures for the staff member's dismissal.
