Safeguarding at TAS

One of the ways in which we make sure your child is safe is by implementing our responsibility to take all necessary steps to ensure the safety and welfare of all the children in our care in line with the procedures laid out by our local Safeguarding Partnership ("LSP"). TAS Designated Safeguarding Lead is Vanda and secondary is Demi.

Reminders for parents Please ensure you are sending sufficient nappies and wipes for your child.

Can we kindly remind you that if a child gets sick during nursery hours please make arrangements to collect them as soon as possible.

Please make sure your child has spare labelled clothes at all times.

Labelling - All children's spare clothing and school uniform MUST be labelled, to avoid confusion in the cloakroom.

FIRST AID & MEDICATION

In our setting staff are able to take action to apply first aid treatment in the event of an accident involving a child or adult. All staff at Tots and Scholars are trained. The first aid qualification includes first aid training for infants and young children. We aim to ensure that first aid training is local authority approved and is relevant to staff caring for young children.

• To identify the first aid needs of the setting

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- To ensure that first aid provision is available at all times when people are on premises, and also off the premises whilst on School trips
 - To appoint the appropriate number of suitably trained people as First Aiders and Appointed Persons to meet the needs of the School and to maintain current qualifications for those people
- To ensure that within the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) at least one person with a current paediatric first aid certificate is on the premises at all times when children are present and accompanies children on outings. The course content will cover that required for St John Ambulance or Red Cross paediatric first aid training, and be renewed every three years.
- To provide relevant training and ensure monitoring of training needs
- To provide sufficient and appropriate resources and facilities
- To inform staff and parents of the Setting's first aid arrangements
- To keep accident records and to report to the HSE as required under the Reporting of Injuries, Diseases and Dangerous Occurrences Regulations 2013 (RIDDOR)

We ensure that suitable accommodation is provided in order to cater for the medical and therapy needs of children. At least one member of staff with current first aid training is on the premises or on an outing at any one time. The first aid qualification includes first aid training for infants and young children.
