Outing to the Park

One of our main goals here at Tots and Scholars is to engage with our local community, to discover the nature and the beautiful scenery around the setting. Therefore we are delighted to confirm that our first outing to the local park behind the nursery. We looked at the natural resources around us, discovered creepy crawly friends and embarked on an adventure where the children were able to learn, explore and discover!

Sciene

We have started weekly science classes with your little ones. This week our science topic was 'floating and sinking'. We explored with different items in our magical box and experimented with these by putting them in a container of water and finding out whether they would float on top of the water or sink to the bottom!

Cooking

In our cooking activities this week the children made and created biscuits. The little ones were helping to identify the ingredients that were needed to make our homemade biscuits, as well as learning how to measure out ingredients, strengthening their understanding of quantities, more and less. Of course our favourite part of our biscuit cooking, was the taste test once they had all finished baking!

Toddler Room - Home Corner

We introduced real fruits and vegetables for the Toddler Room in the Home Corner to find out about different textures, natural resources and to begin the journey of sensorial exploration.
