Key person Policy and Procedure

Tots and Scholars operates a key person system. This means that a nominated member of staff will have special responsibility for your child. In the case of your key person being on holiday or sickness leave, there will be a named secondary key person.

The child's key person will settle him/her into the nursery and will be responsible for meeting his/her direct and indirect needs. The key person will communicate regularly with parents regularly regarding what your child has been doing while at the nursery and also discuss his/her progress with you. As the child develops, the key person might change due to room movement, change in room staff, etc. Please note that the children are constantly exposed to interaction with all staff in the setting and we make sure that their transition is always smooth and based on their needs.

The key person will be responsible for monitoring and updating their child's development journal.

All parents will be involved in meetings with their child's key worker.
